Visit to the University of Oxford Monday 30 April 2018

We have identified your child as one who has the potential to achieve outstanding A level grades, and with support and guidance should apply for the most competitive university courses and apprenticeships. Much of the work regarding university applications will start in earnest in June, however, there are additional activities that we put in place to provide additional guidance and to further encourage and support our high attainers.

As part of this programme, we are organising a visit to the University of Oxford on Monday 30 April 2018.
