Chromebook update

The chromebooks which were ordered by those parents who opted into our voluntary 'Chromebooks for Learning' initiative are presently being made ready for the students to use. They will be delivered directly to students at some point over the coming week, and all will be given some initial training as part of their Computing/ICT lessons this term.

New orders

For those who did not enrol on the voluntary scheme in July, but who now wish to do so, there will be another opportunity to access the portal to order a device from FRIDAY 7th SEPTEMBER until FRIDAY 5th OCTOBER.

Providing your own chromebook

If you opt instead to provide your own chromebook, it must meet the specification on the website information page, and you will be required to purchase a Google Education license (£19) from the school to enable it to be managed by our domain.
