Luggage

Each person has an allowance of one bag/suitcase for the hold in the coach plus one piece of hand luggage.

Currency

The currency in Germany is the Euro. Students may require sterling at the UK service stations and the tunnel terminals. It is recommended that students take approximately £20 in sterling and 50 euros, however this is just a guideline. All students must take responsibility for their own money.

<u>Culture</u>

Visiting a different country is a rewarding and exciting experience and students are expected to respect the cultural differences.

Medication

If you take any medication, this must be handed to Mrs Carroll in the Bus Park. Please label it clearly with a name, purpose and how often and when it is to be taken. If you suffer from travel sickness, please take your medication in sufficient time for it to be effective during any journey. During the visit, in exceptional circumstances, paracetamol can be provided to students for pain relief. If you do not wish paracetamol to be given to your son/daughter, please let me know in writing before departure.

Food

The accommodation is full board and a packed lunch will be provided when we our out on activities.

Mobile Phones/Valuables

If you have to bring anything of value (e.g. mobile phone, camera etc.) please take extreme care of it. Students may be asked not to use mobile phones at specific times as instructed by members of staff. The cost of making and receiving calls in Germany is more expensive than in the UK.

ID Cards

Students will be provided with an Identification Card. This will provide details of the accommodation's address and telephone number as well as the emergency contact number for the visit. Students must carry this at all times in case of an emergency.

<u>Passports</u>

Do not forget your passport. This must be handed in to Mr Power in the bus Park before departure.

EHIC

Do not forget your EHIC card. This must be handed in to Ms Davies in the bus Park before departure.

Health and Safety

It is essential that students listen carefully to instructions. Information and instructions are given for the safety of everyone and must be adhered to at all times.

Head Counts

Students will be allocated a 'head count' group. This will be used frequently during the visit.

Insurance


We are covered under NST insurance policy.
