### **A-Level Geography Fieldwork**

As part of the A-Level Geography course students need to undertake a selection of fieldwork. As you will be aware, the Lake District visit is going ahead from Wednesday 10 – Friday 12 July 2019. The Parent's Information Evening for this will be held on **Wednesday 22 May at 5.30pm in M2/M3** (the classrooms near reception).

In order to prepare students for this, we are organising an afternoon for each class in Tadcaster to carry out some fieldwork investigations on the Changing Places topic that they will begin in February. Each class will be out of school for one afternoon and will only miss one Geography lesson. The information for each teaching group is below:

12D – Tuesday 19 March (PM)

12A – Wednesday 27 March (PM)

As some students may not have timetabled lessons on the morning of the visit, students can meet us in Tadcaster at 1pm. The meeting point will be next to the Fox and Hounds Pub (near the Esso garage), opposite the Heineken Brewery. If students are in school, staff will meet them to walk into Tadcaster together, this will be arranged during Geography lessons. At the end of the session students can then either depart from Tadcaster Town Centre or return to school with staff.
